Menu Changes

With the launch of the Government's new school food standards on healthy eathing, there have been some minor adjustments to the current school menu. On Wednesdays, weeks 1 & 2, mashed potatoes will be served, weeks 3 & 4, it will be roast potatoes only. Yorkshire pudding will not be served at all. This will come into effect from 19th January 2015. A copy of the menu is attached for you.

Milk

From January 2015, all schools are legally required to offer pupils the opportunity to have milk during the school day. Your child should have brought a letter home with more information. If you would like your child to have milk and are not entitled to Free School Meals, please pay £1.10 each Friday which will entitle your child to milk each day for the following week. The money should be put in an envelope with your childs name and class clearly marked. This will commence from 23rd January 2015.
