Did you know ... just registering your child for Pupil Premium means that the school gets extra funding and resources?

Register now to make sure the school can provide the best for all our children

- The Government is giving additional funding to ensure all children reach their full potential
- This funding is called 'Pupil Premium' and is £1320 per child

This additional funding can really help support the school with;

- ensuring all pupils achieve their potential and have the best possible opportunities at Moorlands
- a range of interventions and support
- funding additional staff
- help with costs of school trips, music fees, after school programmes and equipment
- Providing a free school meal, if required, if your child is in KS2
- Funding additional costs such as uniform and other personal equipment

Next Steps

- Registration is simple and will take less than one minute.
- If your child already receives a free meal in Reception or years 1 and 2 you will still need to register.
- Please turn over for details of how to do this which will benefit both your child and the wider community.

How Do I Register?

1. First, check if you think you qualify
2. Registering is really quick and easy. Please complete the attached form. **All we need is 3 pieces of information (Your name, date of birth and NI number)**
3. If you don't want your child to have the school meals they don't have to. As long as you qualify and are registered, the school will receive £1320 to support your child and their classmates.
4. You only need to complete this form once and it will last for the duration of your child's time at Moorlands
5. **All successful registrations will be entered in to a raffle for a £30 book token**

No one will know you have registered and it will not affect any other benefits you are claiming.

Do you qualify?


You can register your child for Pupil Premium if you get any of these benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) that does not exceed £16,190
- Working Tax Credit 'run-on' - the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit
