Learning

This week in English the children have been enjoying poetry. They have listened to a range of poetry and have been performing poems adding their own actions. They have investigated rhyming words and written their own rhyming poems. The have learned about onomatopoeia and that words can represent sounds and have added them to their own poems and then performed them to the class.

They also learned about reading scales and especially reading thermometers on a vertical scale and reading scales when measuring the weights of objects using horizontal scales. You could practise using these websites:

Also we learned about capacity and how liquid is measured in litres and millilitres and how a container can be full, half full and empty. In science the children also learned about wearing warm clothes in the winter to protect from the cold and keep the warmth in. They looked at different fabrics and how they could insulate an object. In art the children created farming pictures using different media.
