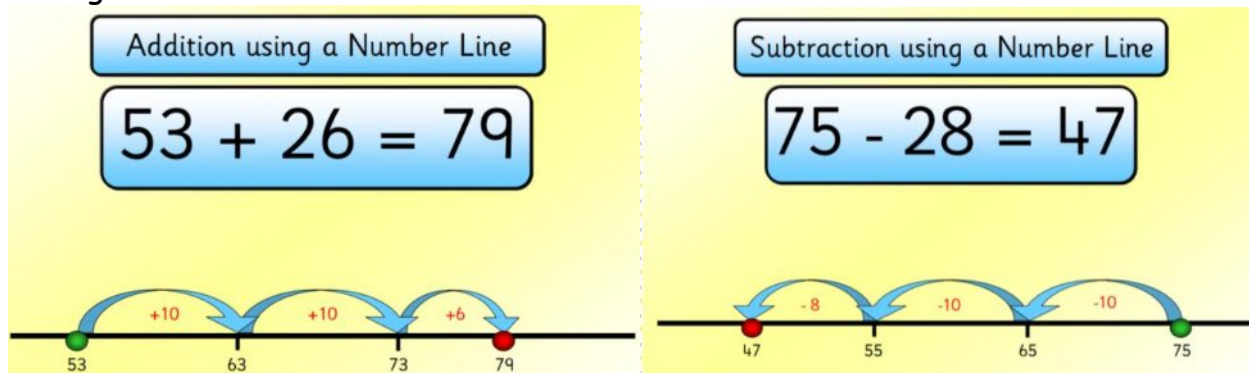

Learning

In English this week the children have been consolidating the unit of work on recounts by retelling stories they have been told and creating their own story map of their trip to Tesco. They used the map to write an extended piece of writing about the trip in the correct order adding any details they particularly remembered or enjoyed. They used words such as first, then, next, after that and finally to sequence their writing.

In maths the children have been working on improving their addition skills using a number line to count on, a bead string and also using a blank number line to count on by adding tens and then the ones.



They have started to work on subtraction using similar methods but counting back using different methods and resources.

In topic lessons the children have looking at the work of the artist Georgia O' Keeffe. The children made their own large flower pictures using different media. In science they looked at different animals and how we are the same but also different. They worked together to sort different animals into groups of their choosing and the presented their work and ideas to the rest of the class.
