- 7 Previous first place winner may not exhibit that same item in the show in future years.
- 8 All decisions made by the committee and/or the judges shall be final.
- 9 Cups and shields will be presented towards the end of the day's viewing session and are held until the following year's show.
- 10 All exhibits must be collected immediately after the show.
- 11 Children and Young people are welcome to enter any of the adult classes
