Learning

Hedgehogs:



This week in maths the children have been learning all about place value and the value of 2 digit numbers. They have made numbers using base 10, using 10p and 1p coins, place value cards and also using an abacus. They have used the resources to compare and order numbers and solve real life problems.

In English the children have been using the story of Cinderella as the focus of their learning. They retold the story, wrote questions using a question mark correctly, wrote a character profile of the princess and finished the week writing a detailed description to find the missing princess for the Prince.

In topic and science lessons the children, they children have been learning about healthy food, making a party hat and learning about the different seasons.

Squirrels: This week in Maths the children have been learning to use partitioning trees to help find different ways to make a number. They have been using base 10 and counting on in tens to help solve different problems using this.



In English, they have been discussing the events of Cinderella, creating a story map and retelling the story in lots of detail.

In topic, the children have been learning what makes a healthy plate.

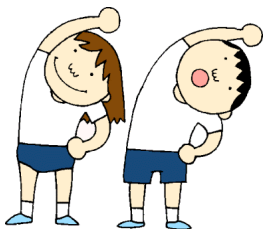
