Maths

- ✓ Count, read and write numbers up to 50 in numerals.
- ✓ Represent numbers up to 50 using objects and pictures.
- ✓ Compare numbers using language such as equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.

English

- ✓ Daily reading and phonics.
- ✓ Sequencing the events in 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' story and writing about their favourite part.
- ✓ Learning to name letters of the alphabet and matching capital letters to lower case letters.
- ✓ Using a capital letter for names and for writing 'I'.

Topic/Foundation Subjects

- ✓ Discussing healthy and unhealthy foods.
