Hedgehogs

In English this week the children have been developing their story writing skills; they practised writing a story setting; creating and describing a main character; retelling a story and writing a story mountain to develop a problem and its resolution to add to their story writing.

In maths the children have been learning about right angles, and clockwise and anticlockwise turns. Also, adding 2 digit numbers using base 10 and blank number lines.

Squirrels

In English, the children have been continuing to look at recounts. They planned what they were going to include in their recount about their school trip. They

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then were able to write a detailed recount all about their visit to the Transport Museum. The children remembered that recounts must include time connectives and be written in past tense.

In maths, the children were naming properties of 3D and 2D shapes. They were also learning about clockwise and anti-clockwise turns. Later on in the week, the children were learning to make the same amount of money in two different ways.

Rabbits

Work in English this week has continued to use the theme of the weather, with children generating adjectives to describe different kinds. They wrote an acrostic poem about a chosen type of weather using the adjectives they found.

In maths, the children consolidated their knowledge of number facts e.g. doubles, addition bonds to 10 and 20 and used them to solve addition and subtraction problems. The children began work on the theme of 'The Weather'.
