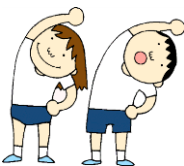


# Home Learning



## 29<sup>th</sup> September 2017

Phonics, Literacy & Numeracy	Reminders and Next Week's Learning
<p><b>Home Learning Sheets will be provided weekly to share the learning which has taken place during that week at school and looks ahead to the following week.</b></p> <p>Our main focus for this week has been to get to know the children and to introduce the rules and routines. Please talk to your child about our class rules: 1). Use good manners all the time; 2). Be nice, using kind words and hands and 3). Always listen to adults and ask for help if we need it.</p> <p><b>In Phonics we have played a range of games to help identify the initial letter sounds (phonemes) in words and begin word building. See if your child can clap the syllables in their name or some of their toys at home.</b></p> <p>In Literacy we read the story 'So much' by Trish Cooke. We then matched or wrote labels to accompany our family members. See if you can label simple items around the house or in books this weekend.</p> <p><b>In Maths this week the children have been singing counting songs and working on their number recognition to 10. See if your child can recognise and order the numbers 0-10.</b></p> <p>The Reception Team have begun uploading learning observations to Tapestry. Remember to add your own learning observations too. Your child's class teacher will comment on any uploads you make.</p>	<p><b>Next week we will base our learning on 'Harvest and Healthy food.'</b></p> <p>The children will continue their P.E sessions on Tuesday next week. We will only be taking our shoes and socks/tights off for this lesson as an introduction. We will let you know when the first full change is planned.</p> <p><b>Please remember to label all of your child's clothes and school items. We are already finding that some of the children's belongings are going missing.</b></p> <p>A big thank you to Isabelle's mum and dad for bringing in baby Flynn to meet us this week. We learnt lots about how to look after babies.</p> <p><b>Each child has been allocated a Key Person - this information has been displayed using the children's portraits in the classroom corridor.
