### **Library Books**

We have spent a significant amount of money on new books over the past few months and are trying to keep the number of lost and damaged books down to an absolute minimum. Before your child brings home a library book, please talk to them about how to look after it properly and ensure that it doesn't get lost. Normal wear and tear is, of course, absolutely fine but last year several books were returned that had been covered in fruit juice, chewed by dogs or dropped in puddles! If books are lost or seriously damaged, we will be asking parents for a contribution of £5 to help cover the cost of replacing them.

### **School Premises**

Also we cannot allow parents to walk around the school when dropping children off in the morning and picking up at the end of the school day. If you require any information or help, please come to the main office.

### **No Nuts Policy**

Its very important we work together and follow our 'No Nuts Policy', please ensure your children have a nut free packed lunch and any snacks when at school. We have had several cases where Nutella sandwiches have been brought into school. We cannot allow this to happen as we have several children who have a severe nut allergy which can be life threatening.

### **Belongings**

Can we please ask that all children bring a water bottle to school and on hot days a sun hat and sun cream.

We are asking children to take home all belongings at the end of each week. This includes any PE kit, coats, lunchboxes or trainers. Hopefully this will reduce the amount of lost property that accumulates in the school and also will allow the cleaners to thoroughly clean the cloakrooms. Many thanks in anticipation.

### **Breakfast and After School Club**

Please ensure your child or children are pre-booked into both clubs. Due to adult to children ratios, this service may not be available if you have not booked.
