In maths, the children have been focusing on additive reasoning. They have been working

on their number bonds to 20 and started focusing on making the inverse number sentences for addition

This week in English we have created a character profile of Bob from 'The Man on the Moon' and described him using a variety of adjectives. We thought of questions to ask Bob and wrote them down using a question mark. We were very excited to receive a letter back from Bob providing answers to all of our questions!

In maths this week, the children worked hard to represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10. They began to solve simple one-step problems involving addition and subtraction using concrete objects and pictorial representations. They were successful at solving missing number problems such as 3 + ? = 10
