Phonics, Literacy & Numeracy	Reminders and Next Week's Learning
<p>Home Learning Sheets will be provided weekly to share the learning which has taken place during that week at school and looks ahead to the following week. It is very important that this letter is read each week.</p> <p>In phonics this week we have continued learning about letter sounds (phonemes). The children have been introduced to /e/ as in egg; /u/ as in umbrella; /r/ as in rag and /h/ as in hop. Previously we have introduced /s/, /a/, /t/, /p/, /i/, /n/, /m/, /d/, /g/, /o/, /c/, /k/ and /ck/. Please practise saying these phonemes at home, see if you can find them in books or when you are out and about.</p> <p>We have also introduced the Tricky Word Tree which contains the high frequency words it, is and in.</p> <p>In literacy we have based our learning around 'The Jolly Postman' by Allan Ahlberg and the children have been writing a list for the postman's round. See if your child can help write a list at home this week for the weekly shop, jobs etc.</p> <p>During maths we have been ordering numbered envelopes for the postman. See if your child can correctly order numbers 1-5; 1-10, 1-20 or beyond!</p> <p>Both classes will have an open Phonics session next Tuesday at 9am when parents are able to attend. If you would like to come please see your class teacher as places are limited.</p>	<p>Next week we will base our learning around doctors, nurses and dentists. If you or a family member complete one of these roles we'd love to invite you in to talk to the children about your job. Just let us know if you're happy to do so.</p> <p>A massive thank you to Millie's mum for coming into school and talking to the children about her job working for Royal Mail. We learnt so much!</p> <p>Due to limited space on the children's pegs please ensure you place their book bags in the box provided for each class. If your child doesn't have a book bag please place their reading book and record directly into the box.</p> <p>Your child's Literacy Next Step has been reviewed this week and a sheet explaining their progress has been sent home.
