Phonics, Literacy & Numeracy

In Phonics we have introduced the phoneme /ure/ as in pure, this is the last phoneme of Phase 3. These are the other phonemes we have learnt so far - /s/, /a/, /t/, /p/, /i/, /n/, /m/, /d/, /g/, /o/, /c/, /k/, /ck/, /e/, /u/, /r/, /h/, /b/, /f/, /ff/, /\/, /\\/, /ss/, /\\/, /v/, /w/, /x/, /y/, /z/, /zz/, /qu/, /ch/, /sh/, /th/, /th/, /ng/, /ai/, /igh/, /ee/, /or/, /oa/, /ar/, /oo/, /00/, /er/, /ur/, /ow/, /oi/, /air and /ear/. Please practise saying these phonemes at home, see if you can find them in books or when you are out and about.

We have also looked at Our Word Tree which currently displays the high frequency words it, is, in, the, I, go, we, me, be, he, she, was, my, you and they.

In literacy we have been focusing on empathy when reading stories and made adverts for 'The perfect friend.' See if you can find some adverts in newspapers, magazines or on billboards.

During maths we have been making o'clock and half past times when retelling the Chinese Zodiac Race story. See if your child can identify o'clock and half past times on clock or watch at home.

After Half Term we will base our learning on Spring & Castles. Try to visit a park, castle or garden centre this half term to get your child talking about our new topic.
