Phonics, Literacy & Numeracy	Reminders and Next Week's Learning
<p>In Phonics we have practised all the phonemes and our segmenting and blending skills. These are the other phonemes we have learnt so far - /s/, /a/, /t/, /p/, /i/, /n/, /m/, /d/, /g/, /o/, /c/, /k/, /ck/, /e/, /u/, /r/, /h/, /b/, /f/, /ff/, /l/, /ll/, /ss/, /j/, /v/, /w/, /x/, /y/, /z/, /zz/, /qu/, /ch/, /sh/, /th/, /th/, /ng/, /ai/, /igh/, /ee/, /or/, /oa/, /ar/, /oo/, /OO/, /er/, /ur/, /ow/, /oi/, /air and /ear/.</p> <p>We have explored segmenting and blending games using the website Phonics Play. Try the game Buried Treasure using Phase 3 phonemes to develop this skill further.</p> <p>We have also looked at Our Word Tree which currently displays the high frequency words it, is, in, the, I, go, we, me, be, he, she, was, my, you, they, so, said, have and like.</p> <p>In literacy we have been writing instructions for how to plant a bean. We used the words first, next and last in our writing. See if you can talk about or write some simple instructions for a daily activity e.g. making a sandwich, brushing teeth etc.</p> <p>During maths we have been completing addition problems and learning number bonds to 10. We have enjoyed singing the number pairs song by Brainzy games on YouTube.</p>	<p>Next week 'Our Learning' will be based around Castles in preparation for our trip on Thursday.</p> <p>Our Norwich Castle trip will take place on Thursday 1st March.
