Learning

Hedgehogs



In English this week, the children continued reading 'Katie's Picture Show'. They described and talked about different paintings. They looked at the picture 'Surprised' by Henri Rousseau. The children changed parts of the story to make up their own adventure that could take place within the painting.

In maths the children have been learning to tell the time to 'o'clock' and 'half past' on an analogue and digital clock, and finding times that are hours earlier or later than a time given. Eg: 4 o'clock → 2 hours later → 6 o'clock. They have used a calendar to find the difference in dates, and ordered the times of their day. The children enjoyed these games:

Squirrels

This week in English, the children looked at poetry surrounding their senses. They looked at the different colours and created a poem using descriptive sentences to describe something that reminded them of that colour. They then thought about their 5 senses and created a poem thinking about things they love to taste, touch, smell, feel and hear.



This week in maths, the children carried on focusing on solving addition and subtraction number sentences using a blank number line. The children put this in context and used this method to add and subtract money. The children then looked at near multiples of ten to help them solve trickier addition and subtraction number sentences.

This week in English the children have been learning about the senses and have labelled the parts of the eye and mouth.

This week in maths the children have been learning to tell the time to o'clock and half past and made their own paper clocks.

TOPIC learning: In topic lessons the children have been learning about the artists Wassily, Kandinsky and Antoni Gaudi and using their work as inspiration for creating their own art work. The children have been making 3D mosaic dragons and papier mache bowls. In science lessons the children have been learning about the importance of keeping our bodies healthy and designed a balanced healthy menu for the week.
