Phonics, Literacy & Numeracy	Reminders and Next Week's Learning
<p>In Phonics we have practised all the phonemes and our segmenting and blending skills. These are the other phonemes we have learnt so far - /s/, /a/, /t/, /p/, /i/, /n/, /m/, /d/, /g/, /o/, /c/, /k/, /ck/, /e/, /u/, /r/, /h/, /b/, /f/, /ff/, /l/, /ll/, /ss/, /j/, /v/, /w/, /x/, /y/, /z/, /zz/, /qu/, /ch/, /sh/, /th/, /th/, /ng/, /ai/, /igh/, /ee/, /or/, /oa/, /ar/, /oo/, /OO/, /er/, /ur/, /ow/, /oi/, /air and /ear/.</p> <p>Try reading simple words using 'The machine' on the ICT games website or more complex words on Obb or Bob from Phonics Play.</p> <p>We have also looked at Our Word Tree which currently displays the high frequency words it, is, in, the, I, go, we, me, be, he, she, was, my, you, they, so, said, have, like, there, out, little, what, one, were, when and what.</p> <p>In literacy we have been writing in our Easter cards ready to give them out next week. Practise name and Easter word writing at home to build on this learning.</p> <p>During maths we have been completing subtraction/take away activities using Easter bunnies, chicks and eggs. See if you can complete a simple subtraction problem at home e.g. toys in a box being taken out, food on a plate being eaten.</p> <p>Your child's Literacy Next Step & Rainbow Words were reviewed this week and their progress has been shared.</p>	<p>Next week our learning will be based on Easter. All children will need a hard-boiled egg in school to decorate on Monday 26th March. Any extras will be gratefully received!
