Learning

Hedgehogs



This week in English, the children have looking at non-fiction texts and writing about the different features of the text. They also wrote their own fact file about their own pet animal or a pet they would like. They also learned about adverbs and applied these to different sentences.

In maths the children have been adding 2 digit numbers together using a pictorial way of helping them calculate the sum of the additions.

Squirrels This week in English the children made their own non-fiction books. They chose two animals and wrote information pages about them. They then created their own contents page and index. They are looking forward to sharing these with Rabbits class next week.



In maths, the children have been looking at using the bar model to help them solve missing number problems. They thought about the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction to help them solve this.

Rabbits



In English the children read a range of non-fiction texts about animals. They answered comprehension questions about the text they had read. Later in the week, they used facts about an animal they had researched for home learning to write their own non-chronological report.

In maths the children were introduced to the 'bar method' to help them work out the known and unknown information in a given word problem. They went on to solve a variety of addition problems, including those with more than one possible answer e.g. *There are 12 eggs in a box. Some are brown and some are white. What could be in the box?*

TOPIC learning:

The children have been learning about food chains, what an animal needs to grow and describing and comparing the structure of different animals. They also really enjoyed a trip to the church to take part in an Easter workshop consisting of a varied selection of different activities.
