Learning

Hedgehogs



This week in English, the children have been using the stories of Little Red Riding Hood and The Three Billy Goats Gruff, to create character profiles and then create their own villain and write its character profile. They have then created a story map of a new story including their villain.

In maths, the children have been doubling and halving 2 digit numbers and moved on to finding different fractions of shapes; such as halves, thirds and quarters.

Squirrels This week in English the children continued looking at traditional tales. They performed the three little pigs and changed the characters to write their own version. The children read the story of the three Billy Goats Gruff and answered questions about it.



In maths, the children have been learning about fractions. They were finding out about halves, quarters and thirds of shapes and numbers.

In English the children have been using the story maps they created last week, to write up their own versions of Little Red Riding Hood.

In maths we have been exploring fractions and focused on finding halves and quarters of 2D shapes and quantities.
