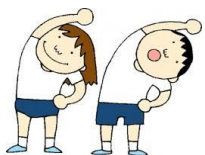


# Home Learning

Phonics, Literacy & Maths	Reminders and Next Week's Learning
<p>In phonics this week we have been developing our fluency in reading simple words and sentences. Play the game 'Pick a Picture' from the Phonics Play website using Phase 3 words to embed this learning.</p> <p>In literacy we have been adding detail to the story 'The Little Red Hen' by using describing words (adjectives). We also thought about different endings to the story. Can you think of, write about or act out a different ending to one of your favourite stories?</p> <p>During maths we have been using our addition skills to make spider sandwiches. All children have attempted to record the numbers used or formed addition sentences. See if you can find Minibeasts this weekend and add together the total number of legs.</p> <p>Your child's maths Next Step &amp; Rainbow Words were reviewed this week and their progress has been shared. Please work on your child's next steps at home, some children have had the same next step for a long while and more practise at home is needed.</p>	<p>Next week we will begin some learning on Minibeasts and focus on <b>Ladybirds</b>.
