Phonics, Literacy & Maths	Reminders and Next Week's Learning
<p>In phonics this week we have been developing our fluency in reading simple words and sentences. Play the game 'Buried Treasure' from the Phonics Play website using Phase 3 words to embed this learning.</p> <p>In literacy we have been looking at speech bubbles using the book 'The Bad Tempered Ladybird' by Eric Carle. The children thought about the characters' thoughts and feelings and wrote these in speech bubbles. Think about or write about what characters might be saying in some shared reading books this weekend.</p> <p>During maths we have been using our subtraction skills to solve problems involving ladybirds and aphids. All children have attempted to record the numbers used or formed subtraction sentences. See if you can use spots on ladybirds to practise take away.</p> <p>Your child's Literacy Next Step &amp; Rainbow Words were reviewed this week and their progress has been shared. Please work on your child's next steps at home, some children have had the same next step for a long while and more practise at home is needed.</p>	<p>Next week we will focus on <b>The Bug Ball</b>. As part of our learning we will be making invitations. If you have some old/unwanted invitations we could have please bring them into school on Monday.</p> <p><b>Bug Ball</b> - On <b>Friday 25<sup>th</sup> May</b> we are inviting all children to come dressed as their favourite minibeast for the last day of term. Prizes will be awarded to the best dressed bugs.</p> <p>We have created a 'My Teacher reads' basket for children to borrow some of our favourite books. If you would like to borrow a book feel free to sign a book out. Please remember that the books must be returned within a week and we will have to charge for books that are not returned, lost or damaged.</p> <p><b>We will continue practising for the Reception Sports Day next week. Your child needs and indoor and outdoor P.E clothing, including trainers and a tracksuit.</b></p> <p>Unfortunately we have noticed that items are being taken home by some of the children. We have spoken to all the children about our core value <b>honesty</b> and that we shouldn't take things that don't belong to us. Please take a moment to speak to your child about this and check your child's book bag for toys/items which are not theirs.
