Phonics, Literacy & Maths	Reminders and Next Week's Learning
<p>In phonics this week we have been focusing on letter names by singing alphabet songs and playing the game 'Alphabet Antics' from the Learn English website. Try playing this game at home over the half term break.</p> <p>In literacy we have been writing invitations to minibests for the Bug Ball. Have a look at old invitations and see if your child can identify features or give them an active part in writing invitations for an upcoming event or celebration.</p> <p>During maths we have been sharing food in preparation for the Bug Ball and solving related problems including halving. See if your child can help share food fairly when dishing up for dinner.</p> <p>Your child's Maths Next Step & Rainbow Words were reviewed this week and their progress has been shared. Please work on your child's next steps at home, some children have had the same next step for a long while and more practise at home is needed.</p> <p>We have created a 'My Teacher Reads' basket for children to borrow some of our favourite books. If you would like to borrow a book feel free to sign one out. Please remember that the books must be returned within a week and we will have to charge for books that are not returned, lost or damaged.</p>	<p>After Half Term our learning will focus on Journeys. Add any special journeys you complete over the half term break to Tapestry.</p> <p>As part of our transition preparations, we will begin talking to the children about moving up to year 1. As part of this we will be visiting the year 1 classes, discuss feelings in circle times and attend whole school assemblies in preparation for September.</p> <p>Please remember the children will have their class photos on Friday 8th June, make sure you look nice and smart.</p> <p>Our visit to Wroxham Barns is on Thursday 12th July - if you paid for the cancelled Norwich Castle trip then this money will be carried forward and taken off the cost of this trip. Please make contributions as soon as possible if not the trip may be cancelled.</p> <p>We will continue practising for the Reception Sports Day after half term. This week the children chose the three races they will be running on Tuesday 10th July.
