Phonics, Literacy & Maths	Reminders and Next Week's Learning
<p>In phonics this week we have been practising our segmenting and blending skills. We are continuing to read and write words containing two letter sounds like /oo/ (digraphs) and three letter sounds like /air/ (trigraphs).</p> <p>In literacy we have been adding sound effects and changing elements of 'The Little Red Hen' story map we created last week. See if you can add sound effects and change parts of some of your child's favourite stories.</p> <p>During maths we have been using scales, measuring scales and measuring spoons to help make the little red hen's corn bread. Each child has a copy of the recipe so why not try making some at home or baking some other treats this weekend.</p> <p>Your child's Literacy Next Step & Rainbow Words were reviewed this week and their progress has been shared.
