## Learning

### Hedgehogs



This week in English, the children have been writing their own recount of an event they have experienced. They applied their learning of time connectives, descriptive writing and added interesting details to bring their writing alive.

In maths, the children have been focusing on multiplication, they have been counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to count money and solve multiplication word problems. They finished the week reading scales in divisions of ones, twos, fives and tens.

### Squirrels

This week in English, the children have focused on writing a recount about a time they went to the beach. They thought of different activities they could do at the beach and created a recount journey map to help them write their recount.



In maths, the children have been practising their multiplication and division skills. They have been thinking of different methods to solve the number sentences and word problems.

### Rabbits



The children began the week creating their own story map based on the 'How to Grow a Dinosaur' story by Caryl Hart. They introduced their own characters and setting. They had some great ideas! The rest of the week was spent using their plan as a guide to write their new version of the story. They were really proud of their work and achievement.

In maths, the children focused on counting, reading and writing numbers to 100 in numerals and words. They learned to recognise multiples of 2, 5 and 10.

### TOPIC learning:

In topic work, the children looked closely at different kinds of seeds before using them to make a collage of a sunflower. They looked at the bean seed they planted last week and observed and recorded the changes.
