Learning

Hedgehogs



This week in English, the children have been learning about nouns, adjectives, adverbs and verbs and used these to write a poem about the animals they saw on their trip. They have created their own story map of a recount of their trip to Africa Alive adding their own additional details. They planned and wrote their own

recount of the events.

In maths the children have been learning about and what the value of each coin and note is worth. They learned to use different coins and notes to make amounts, also trying to make the same amount in different ways. They also were given amounts to spend in the shop and had to work out how much change they would get.

Squirrels

This week in English, the children focused on writing their own recount to the zoo and they thought about the different animals they saw. They draw their own recount journey and boxed up the recount to help them write it at the end of the week.



In maths, the children solved lots of different word problems involving subtraction, multiplication and division. They also solved a problem involving money only, being able to use certain coins to make an amount.

Rabbits



This week in English the children continued to use the story of 'How to Grow a Dinosaur' by Caryl Hart. They used the pictorial map created previously to make a new story by following the plot of the story but changing some of the characters and settings. They took part in whole class shared writing sessions each day, before using the same story map to write the story in their own words. They've all worked really

hard on this!

In maths, the children spent the week using their maths skills and knowledge to solve a range of maths puzzles and problems.

TOPIC learning

In topic work, the children learned about the basic parts of a plant and what seeds need in order to grow. They planted their own seeds and will be observing the changes over the coming weeks.
