Phonics, Literacy & Maths

In phonics this week we have most children have been practising their blending skills through different games and activities. Some children have also been introduced to the phonemes /ay/ as in pay; /ie/ as in tie; /ue/ as in fuel and /ew/ as in new. Phase 5 phonemes taught so far: /ou/, /ir/, /ph/, /a_e/, /oy/, /ea/, /aw/, /oe/, /o_e/, and /e_e/.

In literacy we have based our learning on Pizza for Pirates by Adam & Charlotte Guillain. The children have been writing their own pirate stories to make a class book. Try making a story or book at home this weekend.

During maths we have been learning about coins and calculating change. Give your child the opportunity of paying for something using coins at the shop and receiving change.

Your child's Literacy Next Step & Rainbow Words were reviewed this week and their progress has been shared. Please work on your child's next steps at home, some children have had the same next step for a long while and more practise at home is needed.

Next week our learning will be based on <u>Noah's</u> <u>Ark.</u> The children will spend the day in their new Year 1 class on <u>Tuesday 3rd July</u>.
