Phonics, Literacy & Maths

In phonics this week we have continued practising our segmenting and blending skills by playing Rip it Up. This involves reading words and deciding if they are real or made up. Play the game Buried Treasure from Phonics Play to practise these skills.

In literacy we have been writing about items in Billy's Bucket the story by Kes Gray. See if your child can help to write labels or short sentences based on a shared story.

During maths we have been looking at odd and even numbers, linking it to counting in 2s. The children have particularly enjoyed singing the Odd Todd and Even Steven song.

Your child's Literacy Next Step & Rainbow Words were reviewed this week and their progress has been shared. Please work on your child's next steps at home, some children have had the same next step for a long while and more practise at home is needed.

Thank you to those parents and children who have borrowed books from the 'My Teacher Reads' basket. These books will continue to be available for the next few weeks.

Just to clarify each child reads weekly in Guided Reading sessions, these are recorded but not in your child's reading record.

Reminders and Next Week's Learning

Next week our learning will be based on <u>Under</u> the <u>Sea</u>. Please share any under the sea experiences your child has had via Tapestry.

As part of our transition preparations, we have begun talking to the children about moving up to year 1 in circle time and visited the Year 1 classrooms. No decisions about staffing have been made for the Year 1 classes but we will share this information as soon as we receive it.
