We are now able to offer more information with regards to the activity week we have organised for our year 6 pupils. There will be three days of activities as follows;

MONDAY 9th JULY – Cinema and Picnic

- Your child will need to be in school at normal time
- Your child does not need to be in uniform
- A drink and snack at the cinema is included in the price
- Your child will need - Packed lunch - Light showerproof jacket - Sun hat and suncream - A small bag or rucksack - A small optional amount of spending money up to £5.00
- Your child will be dismissed as normal at 3:30pm

TUESDAY 10th JULY – Pleasurewood Hills

- Your child will need to be in school at normal time
- Your child does not need to be in uniform
- Your child will need - Packed lunch, with plenty to drink - Light showerproof jacket - Sun hat and suncream - A small bag or rucksack - A small optional amount of spending money of no more than £5.00
- We will return from Pleasurewood Hills at approximately 5:30pm (there will be a szapp message if there is any significant change from this time)

FRIDAY 13th JULY - Latitude

Your child will need to be at school at 7:45 am for an 8:00 departure. The coach should be returning to school by 6:00, although we will send a szapp message if there is any significant change in this time. The following information is taken directly from Latitude's website.

'What to Bring - your coach will be parked approximately 25 mins walk from the Children's Arena so we recommend you carry everything you need for the day. The show continues whatever the weather so please ensure everyone is well prepared. Students should carry: - Small rucksack - Re-usable water bottle - Packed lunch - A hat in hot weather - Any medication they need Students should bring a packed lunch. Water bottles or juice cartons up to 500ml are allowed but must be sealed. We recommend children bring a reusable water bottle for free drinking water points. No glass please! Costs on the Day All workshops and activities are free, there are no charges for materials or participation, including items that children take away with them. A small number of organisations have 'pocket money' items available to purchase but these are not prominent. The funfair is subsidised by the festival and charges £1. There is a tuck-shop in the Enchanted Garden.'
