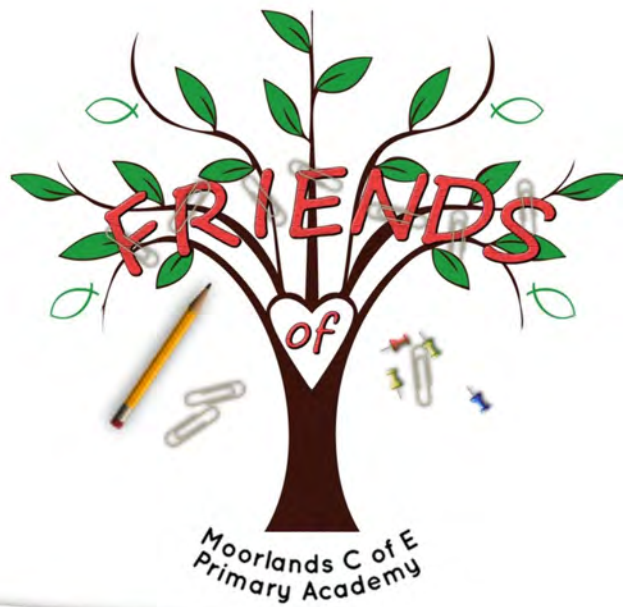

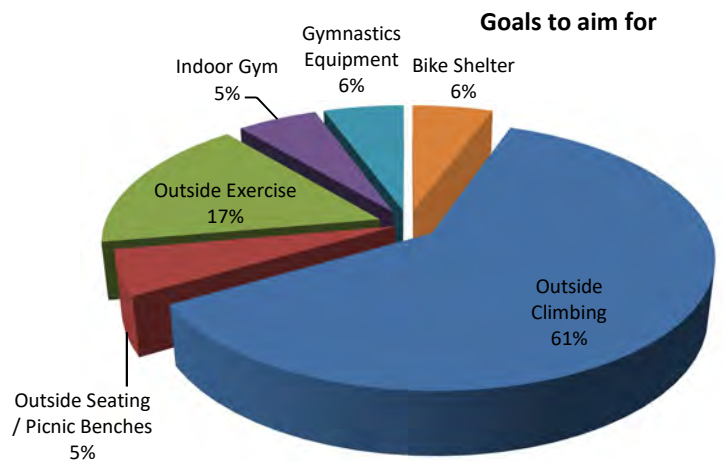
Launch Night

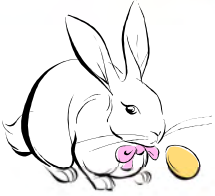
Guess the Babies and Toddlers Competition

Easter Fair

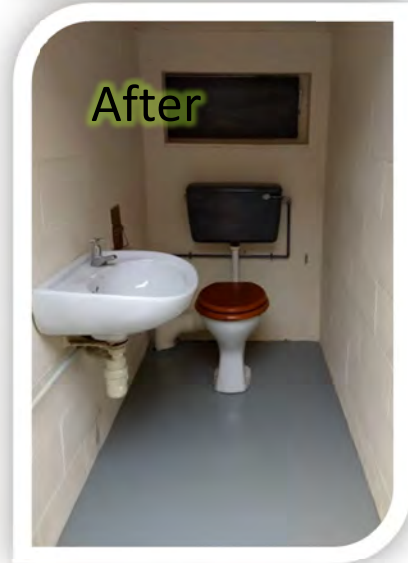
Held on Thursday 22nd March
