### Phonics, Literacy & Numeracy

Home Learning Sheets will be provided weekly to share the learning which has taken place during that week at school and which looks ahead to the following week.

A questionnaire about your child's start to school life will be going live soon via the website and the school App. Please take a few minutes to fill it in to give us your feedback and help us improve.

In Phonics we have played a range of games to help identify the initial letter sounds (phonemes) in words and we have begun word building. See if your child can clap the syllables in their name or some of their toys at home.

In Literacy we read the story 'So much' by Trish Cooke. We then matched or wrote labels to accompany our family members. See if you can label simple items around the house or in books this weekend.

In Maths this week the children have been singing counting songs and working on their number recognition to 10. See if your child can recognise and order the numbers 0-10.

The Reception Team have begun uploading learning observations to Tapestry. Remember to add your own learning observations too. Your child's class teacher will comment on any uploads you make.

If you have any completed letters/forms please hand them directly to a member of staff as book bags are not checked daily.

### Reminders and Next Week's Learning

Next week we will base our learning on 'Keeping Healthy.' If there are any parents who have a job which helps keep people healthy. doctors, nurses, dentists etc, we'd love to hear about what you do. See your class teacher if you are free to talk to the children about your iob.

The children will continue their P.E sessions on Tuesday next week. We will only be changing our footwear. We will let you know when the first full change is planned. Our P.E sessions will only be completed inside until the Summer term.

Please remember to label all of your child's clothes and school items. We are already finding that some of the children's belongings are going missing.

Each child has been allocated a Key Person - this information has been displayed using the children's portraits in the classroom corridor. Make sure you have identified your child's key person to help build this special relationship.
