Phonics, Literacy & Numeracy	Reminders and Next Week's Learning
<p>In Phonics this week we have introduced the phonemes (letter sounds) /d/ for dog, /g/ for gurgle, /o/ for octopus, /c/ for car, /k/ for kite and /ck/ as in stick. The phonemes we have learnt are /s/, /a/, /t/, /p/, /i/, /n/ and /m/. Try recalling each sound with your child or even putting some together to make words e.g. pin.</p> <p>In literacy we read the story 'The Three Little Pigs.' The children helped to sequence pictures of the story and used a story map to help retell the story. This story map is overleaf so see if your child can use it to retell the story.</p> <p>During maths we have been ordering numbers from 1-10 and 11-20, then writing any missing numbers in the sequence. Try ordering numbers at home and writing numerals 0-9.</p> <p>A large proportion of children are finding it difficult to write their name and recognise numbers 0-10. Please practise these key skills with your child.</p> <p>Open Phonics sessions are available on Tuesday mornings (9-9:15am), these sessions give parents an opportunity to watch a phonics lesson. Just let your teacher know if you'd like to attend!</p> <p>All children have now received a reading book and record. Thank you to the parents who attended our 'Reading Workshop' - all the information from this has been sent home.</p> <p>A 'My Teacher Reads' book borrowing system is available to use in the Reception foyer. Feel free to sign out a book and return it within one week.</p>	<p>Next week we will base our learning on 'Bonfire Night, Diwali and Remembrance Day.'</p> <p>The children will continue with their P.E lessons on Wednesdays, we are now completing full changes so make sure your child has a full kit in their P.E bags.</p> <p>A 'My Teacher Reads' book borrowing system is available to use in the Reception foyer. Feel free to sign out a book and return it within one week.</p> <p>All children must have a book bag in school and these must be checked daily.</p> <p>Stars of the week will be announced every Friday and displayed within the Reception Area and on Twitter. 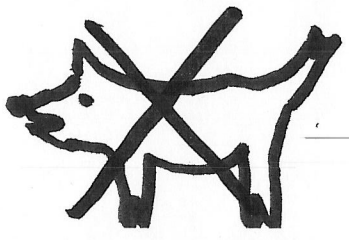
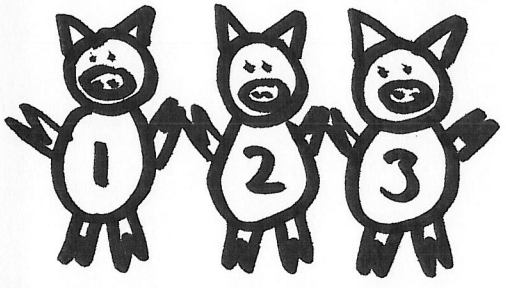
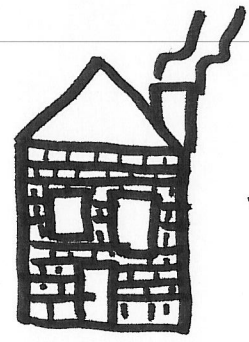
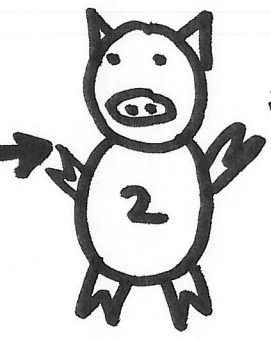
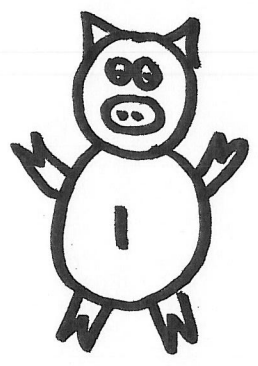
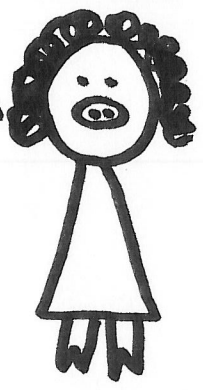
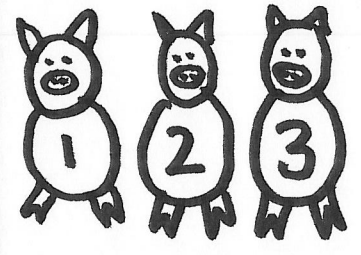


Well done to all the children for completing a full change in P.E - let's see if we can do it even quicker next week!
