Phonics, Literacy & Numeracy	Reminders and Next Week's Learning
<p>In Phonics the children have learnt /s/, /a/, /t/, /p/, /i/, /n/, /m/, /d/, /g/, /o/, /c/, /k/, /e/, /u/, /r/, /h/, /b/, /f/, /ff/, /l/, /ll/ and /ss/. This week we have introduced the phonemes (letter sounds) /j/ for jam, /v/ for van, /w/ for wind and /x/ in box. See if your child can recognise these phonemes and try to write them at home this weekend.</p> <p>We have also introduced the Tricky Word Tree, these words have to be remembered by sight as they are too tricky to sound out. The words we've learnt so far are I, no, the & to.</p> <p>In Literacy we have been adapting the Three Little Pigs Story Map. We've added and changed scenes for the traditional story. See if you can add a scene or change a character/setting for a favourite story.</p> <p>During Maths we have introduced counting in 10s to 100 and used Billy Goats to solve addition problems. See if your child can add two groups of objects together and count on to find the total number.</p> <p>A large proportion of children are finding it difficult to write their name and recognise numbers 0-10. Please practise these key skills with your child.</p> <p>Open Phonics sessions will continue on Wednesday mornings, these have been very popular so we are asking adults only attend one session per term.</p>	<p>Next week we will focus on the traditional story 'Cinderella.'</p> <p><u>Next Steps</u> - Each child has had their Literacy next steps reviewed in class this week. We have shared with you how they got on and to help them move forward it is important that you practise their next step at home.</p> <p>The children will continue with their P.E lessons on Tuesdays and children are expected to fully change.</p> <p>All children must have a book bag in school to help take home letters; work and their belongings.
