STRATEGY STATEMENT

A brief overview of our pupil premium strategy so far is as follows:

- Money spent on full time pastoral support worker which has had a positive impact on the attendance of disadvantaged children
- The achievement of disadvantaged pupils is somewhat mixed across the school
 - o There were only 2 pupils in EYFS which were not statistically significant
 - o 67% achieved their Y1 phonics check. Two hadn't achieved GLD and four achieved 100%. Those that didn't achieve the check scored no higher than 16 (pass mark 32)
 - o In KS1 only 3 of 8 children achieved expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics. Of those who didn't 4 did not achieve GLD. The majority of those pupils made at least expected progress with 63% making better than expected progress in all subjects.
 - o In KS2 disadvantaged children achieved broadly in line with the cohort in the combined measure but achieved significantly better in writing and mathematics. Disadvantaged children also made significantly better progress than both the cohort and nationally in writing and mathematics.

The core approach of our Pupil Premium strategy moving forward is to deliver quality first teaching in the classroom, coupled with a curriculum designed around the needs of our pupils

- The overall aims of our Pupil Premium strategy is to 'level up' opportunities by removing those barriers that we consider to have the biggest detrimental effect on the pupils in school, bearing in mind the school context and the community we serve. If we are successful, we will, over time, close the attainment gap.
 - To reduce the attainment gap between the school's disadvantaged pupils and others nationally by 10 percentage points
 - o To raise the in-school attainment of both disadvantaged pupils and their peers
