

## Basic Practicalities for September

Below is a basic guide to some of the key practical considerations for September. It is based on Government guidance that we have received.

Area	Key Points to Note
<b>Uniform and equipment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Uniform can be worn in September and does not need to be cleaned any more regularly than normal. Please ensure it is labelled clearly with your child's name.</li> <li>Children should only bring in essential items each day. This includes bags, coats, lunch boxes and stationery</li> </ul>
<b>Times of day</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The times of the day will be as normal.</li> </ul>
<b>Drop-off and pick-up</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Classes will have their own entry and exit points as below.</li> <li><b>Nursery:</b> Access via the veranda</li> <li><b>Robins:</b> Access via the door between the main school and nursery</li> <li><b>Hedgehogs:</b> Their own external door</li> <li><b>Squirrels:</b> Their own external door</li> <li><b>Rabbits:</b> Their own external door</li> <li><b>Foxes:</b> Door outside Foxes classroom</li> <li><b>Badgers:</b> External main hall door</li> <li><b>Otters:</b> Girls' changing room external door</li> <li><b>Deer:</b> Their own external door</li> <li><b>Owls:</b> Their own external door</li> <li><b>Eagles:</b> Their own external door</li> <li>We will share a map of these locations before September</li> <li>Please try to ensure social distancing on site and do not congregate on the site or at the gates</li> </ul>
<b>Behaviour &amp; conduct</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Covid-19 behaviour contract that has been implemented since June will still be in place in September with some adjustments to reflect the fact that the whole school is returning. It is the expectation that all children adhere to this and it will be shared with them in the first week back. This will then be sent home to be signed, so please discuss this with your children and then return to school.</li> </ul>
<b>Lunches</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>There will be a full menu of lunch options from our new catering company, Aspens.</li> <li>Lunches will be staggered but this is something that will happen within the school day.</li> </ul>
<b>Playtime</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Children will have breaks but again these will be staggered so that bubbles can maintain their distance</li> </ul>
<b>Collective worship</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>There will currently be no collective worship as a whole school. However, this will take place via Zoom, with all classes joining from their own bubble.</li> </ul>
<b>Meetings</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>It will not be possible to pop for a quick word with the teacher in September. Meetings can be arranged, but will normally have to be conducted by phone or Zoom.</li> </ul>
<b>Breakfast and After School Club</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>There will be no provision for the first two weeks of term. After this, we will run the provision. Uptake needs to be high enough for it to be financially viable for the school to continue to offer the provision and we will keep this under review.</li> </ul>
