7. Children of staff where:

- I. a member of staff has been employed at the school for two or more years at the time at which the application for admission to the school is made and/or
- II. the member of staff is recruited to fill a vacant post where there is a demonstrable skill shortage
- 8. Children who are due to transfer and live outside the area served by the school who attend a school within DNEAT at the opening date of the admissions round.
- 9. Resident out of the catchment area of the school [for explanation of resident and catchment area refer to items 2 and 3 in the clarifications section of Appendix 1]

In accordance with statutory DfE guidance, the consultation will run for six weeks and, as an interested party at Moorlands Primary Academy, we are keen to hear your views on the proposed changes; therefore, we invite you to participate in the consultation if you have any concerns regarding the matter.
