WHAT SUBJECTS ARE STUDIED?

We study the whole National Curriculum. This includes 'core' subjects such as English and Maths, and 'foundation' subjects such as art and languages. The children in the Early Years follow a separate curriculum (The Early Years Foundation Stage)
